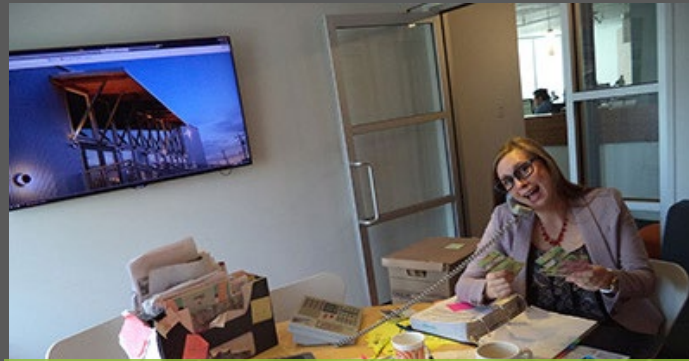

PROGRAM LEADERS



To register in courses at Camosun, your first step is to apply to a program.

Your application is welcome at any time.

Camosun admits qualified applicants on a first-come, first-served basis for September, January, and May starts.

You may pay the \$43.51 non-refundable application fee online.

APPLICATION PROCESS
