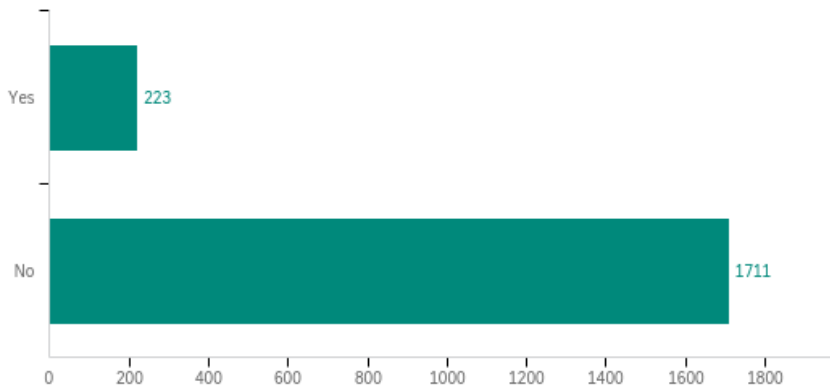

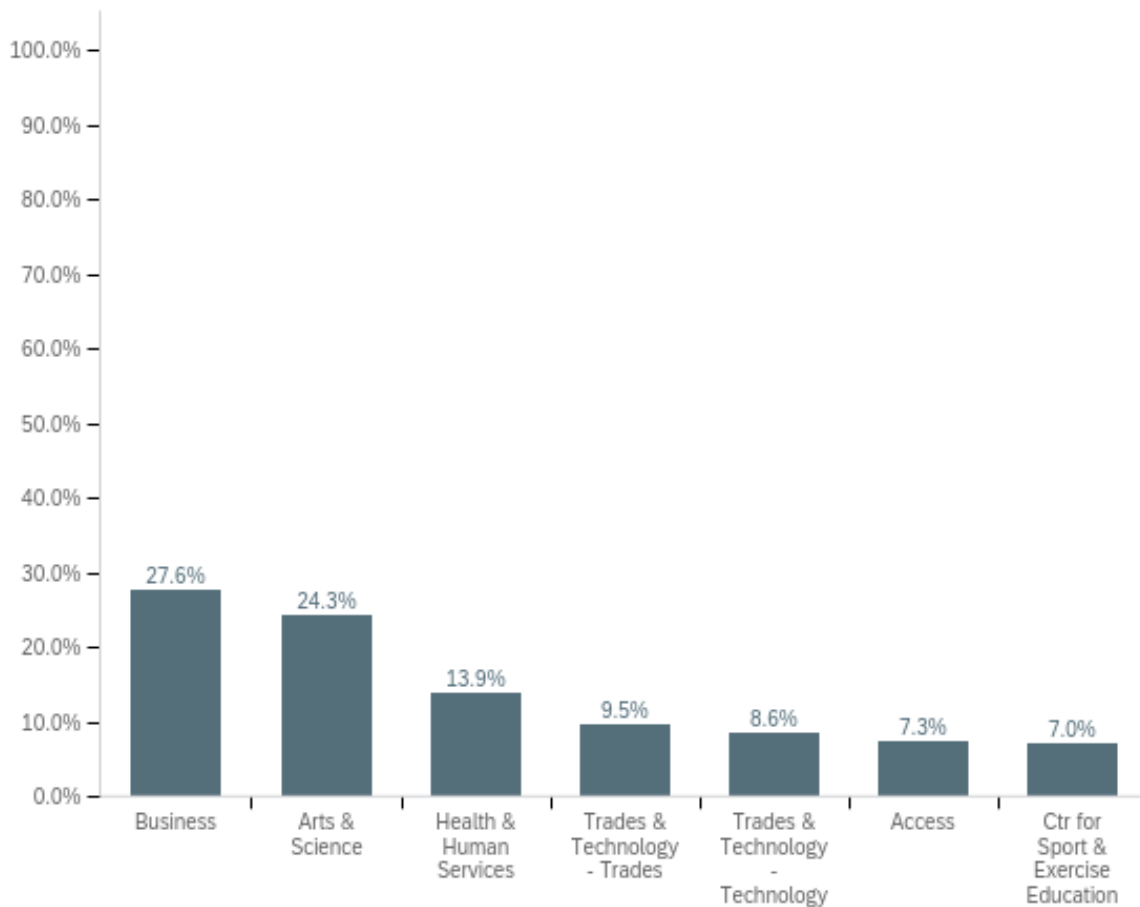

Are you a student in an off-campus community learning partnership program?

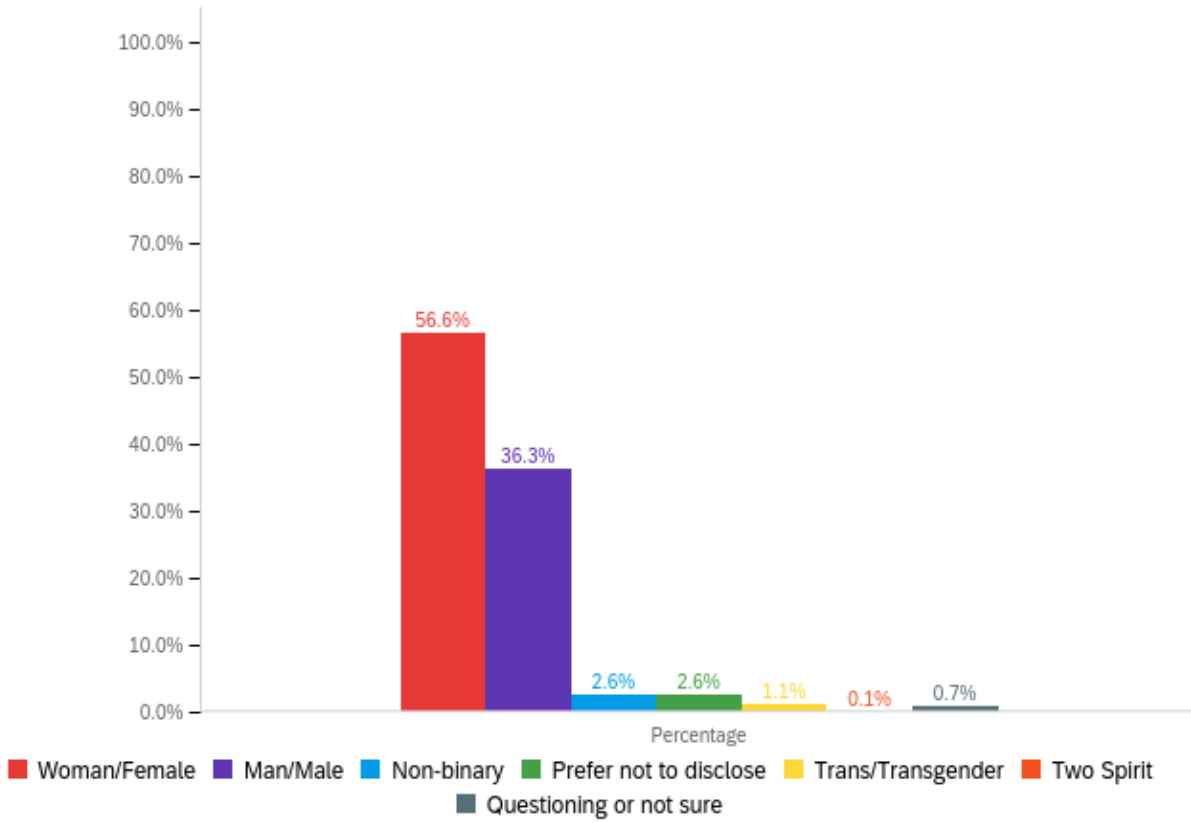

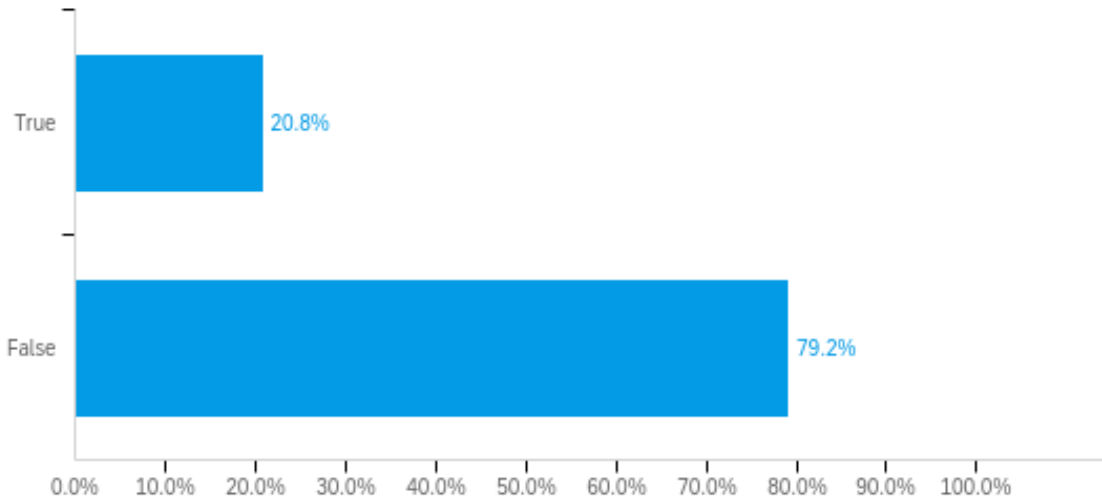
Which of the following categories best describes your ethnic or racial background?

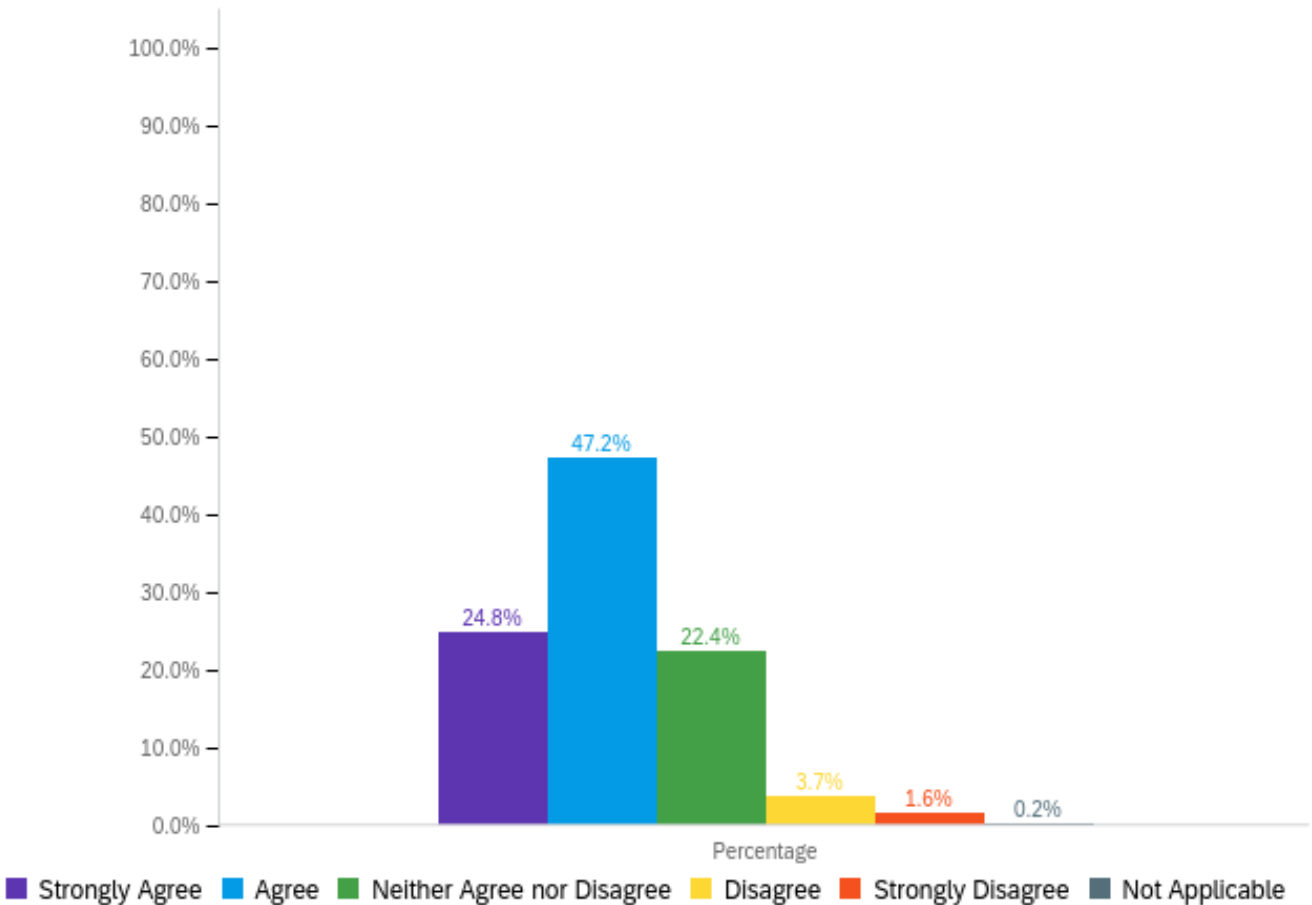

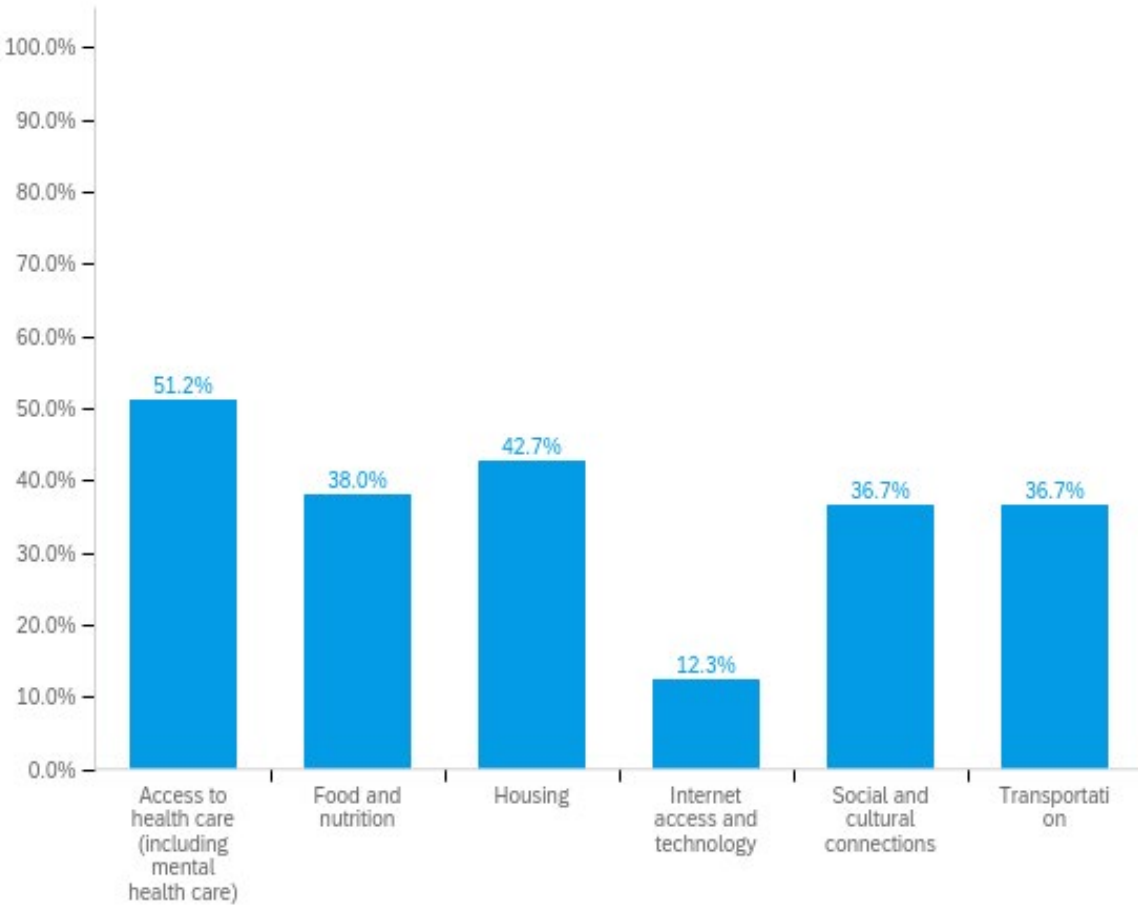
What learning skills would you like to improve?

1,269 responded to this question; nine themes emerged

<p>Learning experience (434 comments)</p> <p>Positive comments about the quality of teaching, the commitment of instructors, and high standards of programs and curriculum.</p>	<p>Engagement and connection (313 comments)</p> <p>Students placed great value in the sense of community, the opportunity to make friends, and being able to engage in activities outside of class.</p>	<p>Services and supports (189 comments)</p> <p>Students commented on how helpful staff are, and about the importance of services and supports to their academic journey.</p>
<p>Personal achievements (122 comments)</p> <p>For many students a personal achievement was the most satisfying—completing a program, achieving a certain grade, participating in project, balancing school, work and family.</p>	<p>Applied learning (104 comments)</p> <p>Student commented on the value of practicums and co-op, and the connection of curriculum to work.</p>	<p>Physical environment (96 comments)</p> <p>Students appreciate the natural environment of both campuses. Student commented on the CHW, Wilna Thomas and the libraries as spaces conducive to learning.</p>
<p>Diversity (67 comments)</p> <p>Students commented on the diversity of the college community, and how they appreciated learning alongside students from different backgrounds and identities.</p>	<p>Flexible options (63 comments)</p> <p>Favourable comments about online and asynchronous offerings, part-time studies and weekend and evening classes that allow working students to pursue studies.</p>	<p>Class size (55 comments)</p> <p>Students appreciate smaller classes, and the benefits of a more personal learning experience.</p>

<p>Engagement, connection, activities (215 comments)</p> <p>Student would like to have more opportunities to connect outside of class.</p>	<p>Learning experience (237 comments)</p> <p>Students commented on quality of teaching, workload demands, limited opportunity to provide feedback on learning experience.</p>	<p>Services and supports (137 comments)</p> <p>Hours of service, wait times for some services limited awareness of what is available.</p>
<p>Operations (130 comments)</p> <p>Tuition and fees, registration processes, waitlists, service delivery mode.</p>	<p>Physical environment (110 comments)</p> <p>More quiet study spaces, more recreational spaces, outdoor spaces, update some of the older buildings.</p>	<p>Transportation (97 comments)</p> <p>Cost and availability of parking; bus availability.</p>
<p>Food services (83 comments)</p> <p>Cost and type of food choice; limited food service weekends and evenings.</p>	<p>Communications (65 comments)</p> <p>Website improvements, desire to have a newsletter about campus events, opportunities to provide feedback.</p>	<p>Flexible options (48 comments)</p> <p>More online offerings; more course offerings on weekends and evenings.</p>
<p>Diversity and inclusion (37 comments)</p> <p>Lack of diversity in the college community; instances of racism and other identity related marginalization.</p>	<p>Housing (27 comments)</p> <p>Desire to have on-campus housing.</p>	<p>Resources: textbooks, equipment etc. (24 comments)</p> <p>Cost of textbooks, condition and availability of equipment and tools.</p>
