

Dear Students,


Hope your Summer is going well for you, either if you are taking courses or enjoying the sunshine!

Registration for Fall 2024 starts on <u>June 17, 2024</u>, and you'll use <u>myCamosun</u> student portal to register for classes. **Please make sure you know what your registration date and time is** so you are prepared.

Registration starts on <u>June 17</u>, but you may have a different date depending on your program and total credits.

## Where can I see my registration date and time?

You can find the date by logging into myCamosun and selecting My Schedule > 2024 Fall tab.



You have been given priority to register on this date. **Registration starts on your assigned date and time,** and it will remain open until **the add/drop deadline** (September 9, 2024).

Please remember that courses may fill up quickly.

We recommend planning and registering earlier (registering as early as possible on your assigned date and time) as to have more chances of securing a seat in the courses you wish to take.



## 3 Easy steps for smooth registration



# 1. Pay registration deposit (\$175)

Make sure your myCamosun account has \$175 or more, or pay a non-refundable \$175 deposit before your registration date.

Log in, go to Student Finance, and click **Make a Payment** to pay with



# 2. Plan ahead & register your courses on the first day of your assigned period

Plan your schedule by viewing available Fall courses in myCamosun. (Make sure to accept your required agreements too!)



#### 3. Pay your tuition fee

All fees must be paid by August 13th, 2024. Fee deadline is BEFORE classes start.

Students who have not paid all fees by this date will be taken out of all classes.



#### How can I check if a course is restricted or reserved?

- Go to "My Schedule" > "Calendar."
- Click on the course name you're interested in.
- View "Section Details" to find additional information indicating restrictions or reservations in the "Additional Information" section.



# What if I'm not planning to attend Camosun in Fall 2024?

Fall term is **NOT** a scheduled break for most Camosun programs. As an international student, you must enroll in full-time classes to be eligible to work off campus and for the Post-Graduation Work Permit (PGWP).

If you won't be able to attend in Fall 2024 due to specific personal reasons, please let us know.

# **Registration Checklist**

#### Please check this before your actual registration starts!

- Check that you have the requisites for your scheduled courses. If you have been granted a requisite waiver, it will display in My Permissions.
- Use the location filter to double-check what campus your courses are scheduled at.
- Check if the section already has a waitlist. Waitlisted courses display
  with a yellow triangle in the calendar and "This section has a waitlist" in
  the sidebar.
- Familiarize yourself with course section definitions. Some sections are restricted to specific programs that you may not be eligible to register for.
- Check if the section is reserved. Some sections are reserved for specific programs until a specific date. After this date, it will open for general registration.
- Consider an alternative section in case your preferred section is full when your registration period begins.
- Check if you have accepted your **student agreements**.
